March 07 Monday 3pm to 6pm	Palau Community College (PCC) Cafeteria	Moderna Vaccines: 1 st , 2 nd , 3 rd doses and/or boosters	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Bring appropriate documentation (vaccine cards, hospital numbers, identification cards, etc). 3rd doses for 65 years old and above, unless with a doctor's note Beginning in March, boosters are available for individuals whose last dose was in October 2021 or earlier. This includes individuals who received their 3rd doses of the Moderna vaccines.
March 09 Wednesday 3pm- 6pm	Palau Community College (PCC) Cafeteria	Influenza (Flu) Vaccines	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Anyone ages 6 months and above Persons under 18 years of age need to be accompanied by adults
March 10 Thursday 3pm – 6pm	Palau Community College (PCC) Cafeteria	Pfizer for 5 years old and above 1 st , 2 nd , 3 rd doses and/or boosters	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Bring appropriate documentation (vaccine cards, hospital numbers, identification cards, birth certificates, etc). (Beginning in March) Pfizer boosters for 12 years old or older whose last dose was in October 2021 or earlier
NOTE: ANY INDIVIDUAL WHO TOOK THE JOHNSON AND JOHNSON VACCINE, OR J3, MAY WALK IN FOR THEIR BOOSTER. BOOSTERS FOR THE J3 CAN EITHER BE THE MODERNA OR THE PFIZER.			

MHHS urges individuals who are positive of COVID-19 to refrain from coming in for their vaccinations until after they have cleared isolation.
