COVID-19 VACCINATION FOR FIRST RESPONDERS, THE ELDERLY, AND PEOPLE WITH UNDERLYING MEDICAL CONDITIONS

The Ministry of Health (MOH) would like to inform the public that COVID-19 VACCINES are now available for first responders, the elderly (beginning with 75+, and then 65+) and people with underlying medical conditions (i.e., diabetes, heart disease, cancer).

There will be three CLOSED points of dispensing (PODS)¹ to vaccinate the following:

MOH is currently calling these individuals to come in for vaccination. If you are 65 years old and over, have an underlying medical condition, or a home bound patient caregiver, please submit (or have a family member submit) your name and phone number to the MOH COVID Hotline at 488-0555. You will be scheduled and informed of your vaccination time. MOH will continue to publish vaccination schedules and details as they become available.

We thank you for your support and understanding, as we wait for more vaccines. If you have any questions or need further information on the COVID-19 vaccine, please contact Gaafar Uherbelau (775-1310) or Edolem Ikerdeu (775-1138).

¹ Closed PODs are not open for the general public, but used to give out vaccines to target groups. These groups of people will be contacted individually to come in for vaccination.
