## **COVID-19 VACCINATION FOR ADOLESCENTS AGES 12-17 OPEN FOR WALK-INS, NO APPOINTMENTS NEEDED**

The Ministry of Health and Human Services (MHHS) would like to inform the public that COVID-19 vaccination for children aged 12 to 17 years old will be open for walk-ins on July 29th and July 31st from 9am to 3pm. No appointments are needed.

Parents or legal guardians must escort their child and sign a consent form before their child can receive the vaccine. Parents and guardians are also asked to provide their child's ID, preferably birth certificate (passport, driver's license, etc.), and hospital number, as well as their own ID at the vaccination point of dispensing (POD) site. If your child does not have a hospital number, please proceed to the Belau National Hospital Medical Records and request for one.

Walk – in vaccination schedules for adolescents (ages 12-17) will be as follows:

Palau National Gym	Saturday, July 31	9am-3pm

The COVID-19 vaccine to be administered for the adolescent age group will be the Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine, which requires two (2) doses administered twenty-one (21) days apart.
