UPDATES ON QUARANTINE, ISOLATION & ENTRY REQUIREMENTS (EFFECTIVE JUNE 1, 2022)

The Ministry of Health and Human Services informs the public of the following updates to isolation, quarantine and other mitigation measures for travelers, effective June 1, 2022:

- COVID-19 vaccination is a requirement for entry for individuals 18 and over. Unvaccinated individuals under 18 years of age are permitted to travel to Palau.
- A negative COVID-19 test result or documentation of recovery is still a requirement for prior to entering the Republic of Palau; however, children under 2 years of age are exempt from this testing requirement.
- Testing after arrival (i.e., Day 4) is no longer required. Travelers are encouraged, however, to get tested 3-5 days after arrival as a precautionary measure, during the days when there is community testing available. Testing schedules are posted on a weekly basis on the MHHS Facebook page and other media outlets.
- Travelers are required to undergo a self-monitoring period for four (4) days. Travelers will monitor their health, and if they develop symptoms during this time period, they should isolate immediately and get tested.
- Travelers are required to wear their masks at all times during the self-monitoring period to protect vulnerable individuals (elderly, children, immunocompromised). Travelers are also advised to refrain from participating in large indoor gatherings or events during this time period.
