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NEW SCHEDULE FOR COVID AND FLU VACCINES

The Ministry of Health and Human Services (MHHS) would like to inform the public that COVID-19 and FLU vaccines are available during the times indicated below. Keep up your protection against COVID-19 by getting your booster.

Wednesdays and Thursdays 3:00pm – 6:00pm	Palau Community College (PCC) Cafeteria	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Moderna – All doses and boosters for 18+• Pfizer – all doses (5+) and boosters (12+)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Everyone ages 12 or older should get your 1st booster shot 5 months after your 2nd dose of Pfizer or Moderna, or 2 months after your single dose of J&J vaccine.
Fridays 4:30pm – 6:30pm	Central Community Health Center I, across Koror Elementary School	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Moderna and Pfizer• Flu vaccines – for 6 months+	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Adults 50 years and older can choose to get a second booster, at least 4 months after the first booster with either Moderna or the Pfizer vaccine.• You may be eligible for an additional dose if you are immunocompromised, including children 5-11 years of age.

It is also safe to get both the COVID-19 and flu vaccines at the same time.
