UPDATED (JUNE 2022) SCHEDULE FOR COVID AND FLU VACCINES AT THE PCC CAFETERIA

The Ministry of Health and Human Services (MHHS) would like to inform the public that COVID-19 and FLU vaccines are available Wednesdays, Thursdays, and Fridays (except on holidays) at the PCC Cafeteria during the times indicated below. Keep up your protection against COVID-19 by getting your booster.

Palau Community College (PCC) Cafeteria	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Moderna – All doses and boosters for 18+• Pfizer – all doses and boosters for 5+• Flu vaccines – for 6 months+ (only on Fridays)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Everyone ages 5 or older can get 1 booster, five months after completing their COVID-19 primary series.• Adults 50 years and older can choose to get a second booster, at least 4 months after the first booster with either Moderna or the Pfizer vaccine. It is advisable that a person who gets infected with COVID-19 after the first booster wait at least 90 days before getting the 2nd booster.

It is also safe to get both the COVID-19 and flu vaccines at the same time.
