The Ministry of Health and Human Services (MHHS) is informing the public of the following changes to COVID testing and clinical care. The schedule below, from **August 29– September 4, 2022**, replaces previously published or announced schedules for travelers and community members.

*Travelers testing at the BNH Laboratory on Thursdays need to complete paperwork/payment at the main MHHS Finance Office and Sundays at BNH ER Medical Records/Finance window before proceeding to the Lab for testing. Results will be available after 3pm on the same day.
-There is no testing on Saturdays.

Testing is free except for travelers. Each test cost \$44.50, for both PCR and rapid antigen. If a printout is necessary, there is an additional processing fee of \$5.50, bringing the total to \$50.00 each test. Inbound travelers who wish to get tested between their day 3-5 after arrival may test at the Testing Center (old morgue) on Tuesday or Friday with community members at no cost.

Individuals who need clinical care for COVID-19 may access services at BNH OPD or the ER.
